

# Reporting and Support Options Following Sexual Violence



Following an experience of sexual violence, someone might be unsure of **where to start**. This chart provides information on the resources available.

**Private resources (P)** are mandatory reporters who will only share information with other offices involved in sexual violence response as needed or required by law.

**Confidential resources (C)** do not have a reporting responsibility and will not share information without your consent. Both private and confidential resources must act in a situation where there is an immediate threat to the health and safety of an individual or the community.
